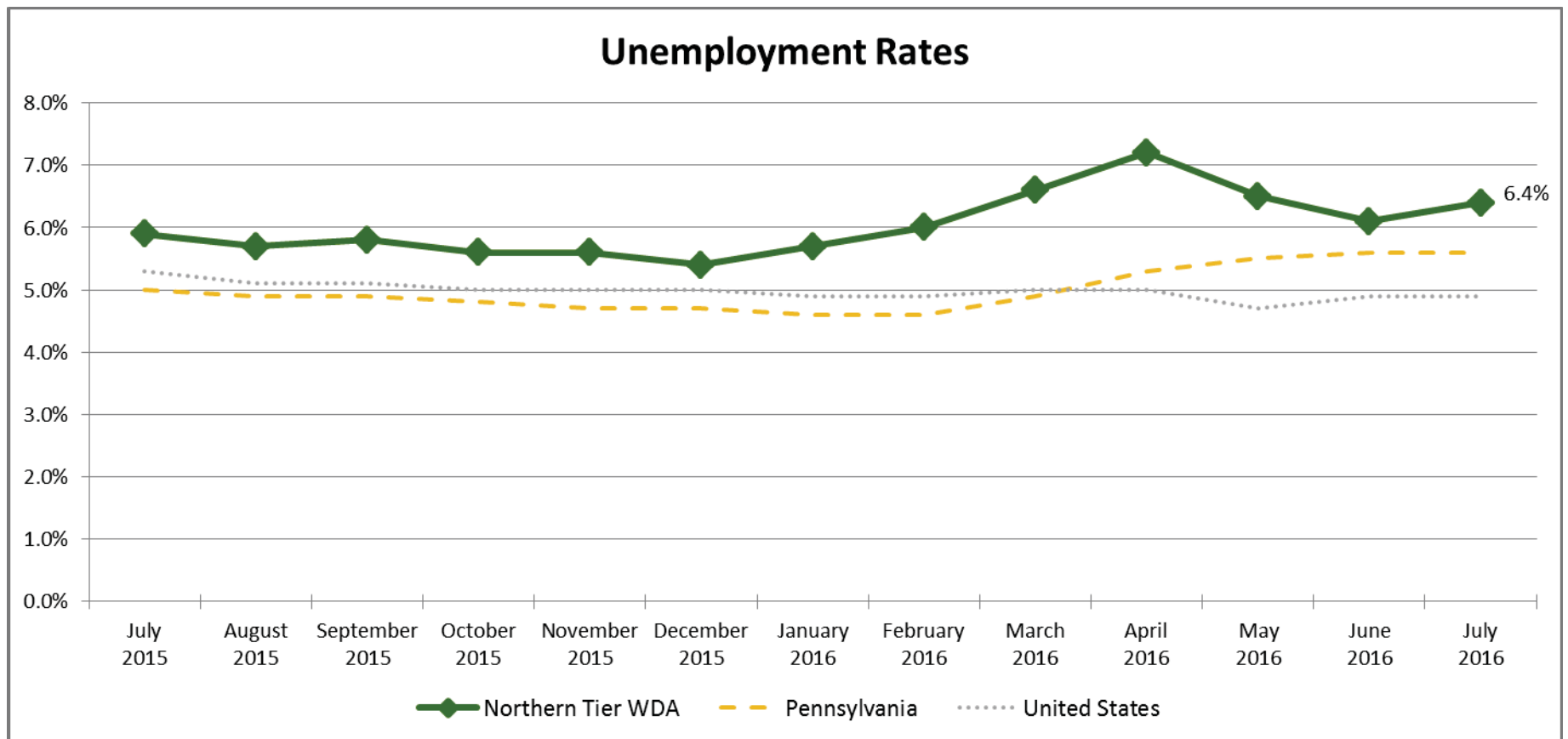

### Civilian Labor Force

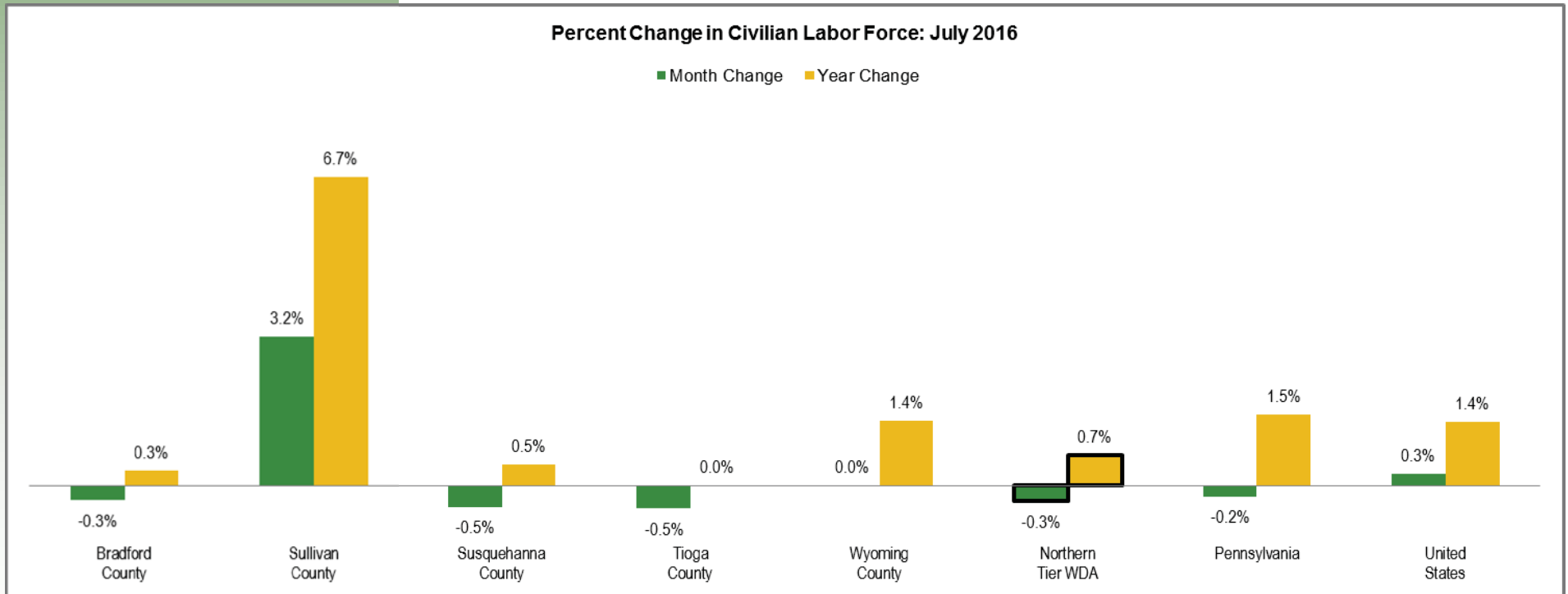

■ Month Change ■ Year Change



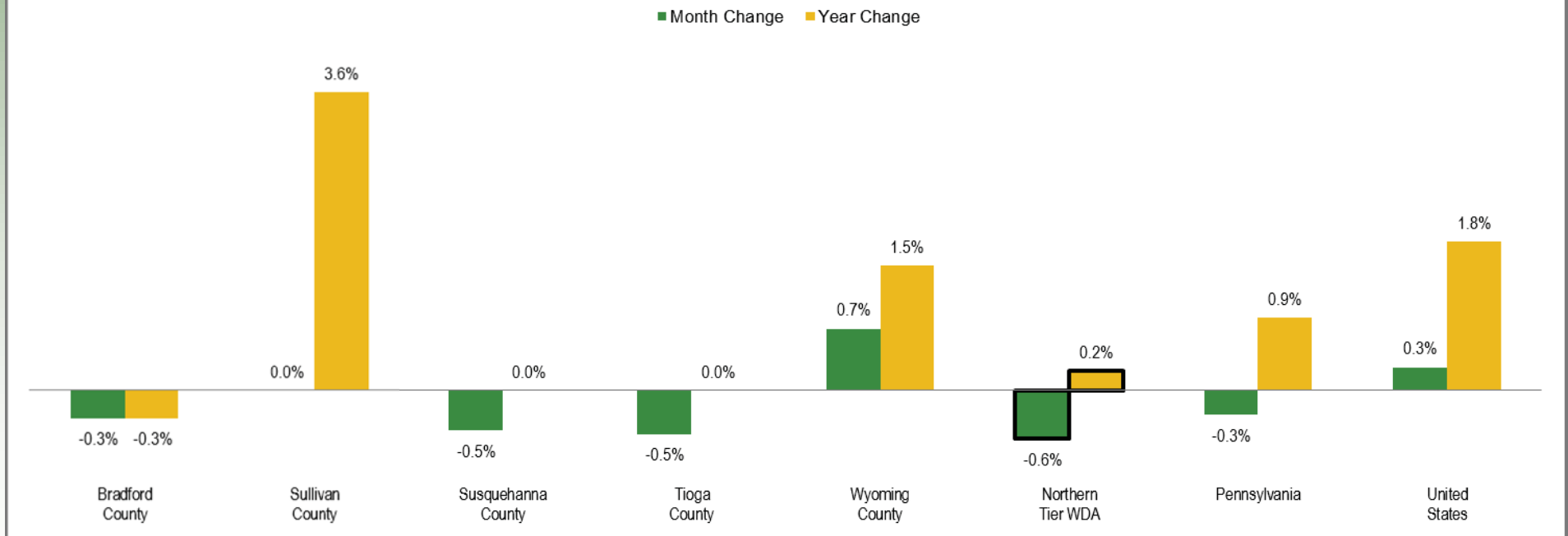

Percent Change in Employed Population: July 2016

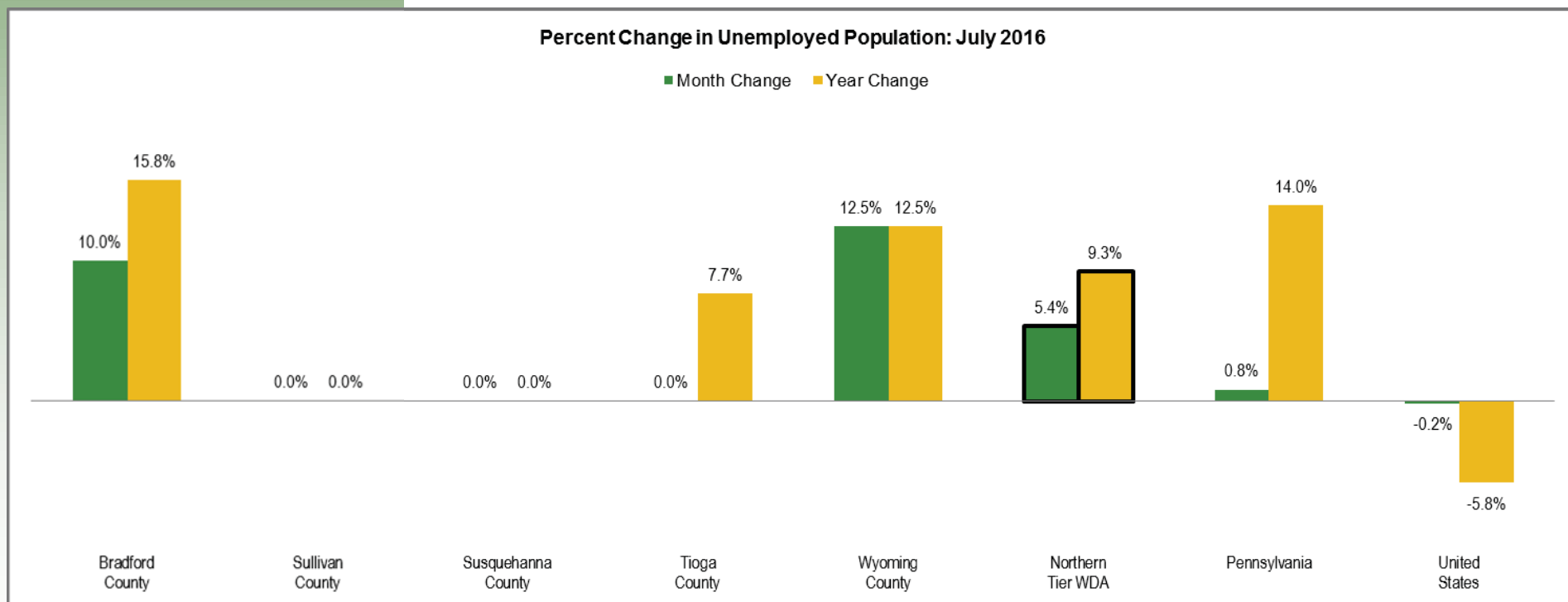


## Unemployed Population
