### C. PENNDOT Reports

Central Office – Carey Mullins announced that the acting Secretary of Transportation Yassmin Gramian was appointed to permanent secretary.

Dist. 3.0 – John Ranck said the bid for the reconstruction project on I-99 came in at \$16.5 million. It should go to construction in 2021.

Dist. 4.0 – Commissioner Hall asked if they would receive the construction maps and information for this year. Rich Roman stated that they are in the process of completing them and should have them out within the next two weeks.

## D. County Reports

- 1. Bradford County Matt Williams said that 5 bridge inspections are complete for the bridge bundle project and the other 3 bridges are getting started on next week. All 8 should be done in 3 years.
- 2. Sullivan County None
- **3.** Susquehanna County Commissioner Hall stated they awarded the bid for the bridge off route 11 near Hop Bottom to replace the deck and beams. Hoping to open the bids on Wednesday for the new 911 centers. COVID cases are still increasing in the county.
- **4.** Tioga County The Marsh Creek projects are starting back up. Commissioner Hamilton stated that they are applying for a Build grant that would fund a link between Jersey Shore and Lock Haven and another portion from Jersey Shore towards the Williamsport

- area. He also stated that they signed agreements to bring up a historic bridge from Chester County.
- **5.** Wyoming County Jean Ruhf said that the courthouse is open by appointment only. Brian Baker will submit invoices for the Mobility Study through the new UPWP.
- E. BEST Report Todd Wright stated that they have been working with PennDOT to purchase parcels for their office expansion and renovation project in Greens Landing. They were able to purchase one and they are waiting on landowner for the other. Looking into a DCED Multimodal grant for a small shelter project in Wellsboro. They have seen a large decline in ridership during COVID, however it is slowly starting to increase again.
